Student Supply List

- Japanese riced paper. I use Ginwashi and Unryu paper. Get the lightest weight. A full sheet is approx. 24x36. We will work on ¼ paper (12x18")
- Watercolor palette
- Watercolor brushes- especially a squirrel mop that can hold a lot of water and paint
 - Watercolor paints. I recommend 5-6 transparent colors of your choice and several opaque/semi-opaque colors (e.g.: Cerulean Blue, Cadmium Red) and white (Titanium White).
- Paper towels
- Reference photographs or a line drawing you can trace at either 12x16" size or smaller.
- Drawing supplies (pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener)
- Container for water
- Appropriate clothing
- 16x20" (minimum) board. Can be plexiglass, gatorboard, wood, or foam core.

Instructor will supply all materials needed for wax including brushes for wax.

Students are welcome to bring their own photographic reference material or may copy the instructors images (copies will be provided)
